ACCESS AND TRANSPORTATION

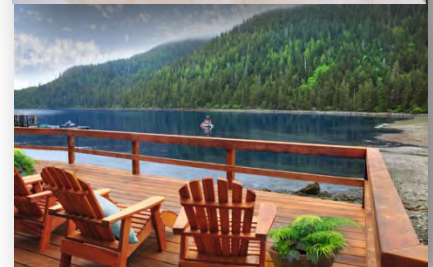
